### Youth Work Training

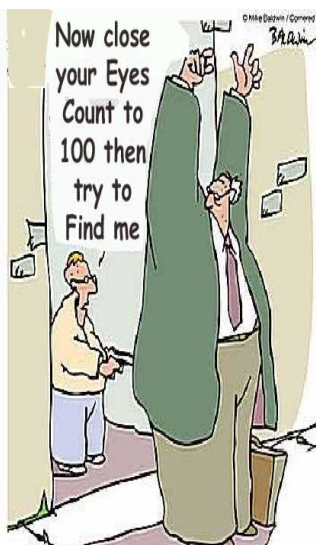
